This year started with heartache: Greg's father, Ken Bixby, died in late January.

Ken was one of our first donors. He was the one who suggested that 'The Pastor Janet Noble-Richardson Memorial Scholarship' was much too long to squeeze onto a personal check. And he was right.

With him in mind, we added 'Remembering Janet' as a doing business as (DBA) designation to the Bixby Foundation. Later, we introduced PayPal as an option for our website users, and Ken never went back to writing checks.

My father-in-law was consistently interested in our charitable work and annually contributed to our scholarship program. With his passing, we raised \$1,650 in his honor through memorial donations. Many of you who read this report are already aware of this, because you are not only treasured donors, but also beloved family and friends who listened to us, cried with us, and helped us see beyond our grief over losing Ken.

Thank you for all the ways you emotionally, thoughtfully, and financially support us and the work we do. Your involvement touches us personally.

#### So, who are the 2019 scholars?


I'm sorry to say, that when you look at the financial statement on the following page, you will notice that scholarships are missing from our expenses. This is because we discovered a step had been overlooked in our incorporation filing, and we decided to delay awards to students until the regulatory issue was resolved. At the end of the year, we were still awaiting determination.

The self-imposed pause in providing awards disappoints us and is unfortunate for the men and women we had chosen for scholarships. I hope you're not disheartened, however, from partnering with us. Your 2019 contribution is earmarked for distribution amongst seven specific and well-deserving students. We hope to introduce them this following year. Until then, Greg and I ask for your ongoing patience.\*

Despite the small setback in achieving all our objectives, we persevered in faith and continued our other charitable work. We released a few posts on our blog, updated our FaceBook page, and made financial contributions to other local and national nonprofit organizations. Several of them mirrored our interest in sharing the gospel of Christ through education, service, and outreach. All were admired for the impact they have throughout our communities.




